## CHECK LIST FOR MOBILE HOME PERMIT

A mobile home permit must be obtained before any mobile home is moved into the county or is moved from one location in the county to another. A mobile home that is older than 12 years, must be inspected and if needed, brought up to code before it can be moved into the county. If you are found to have moved in an older mobile home that has not been inspected it will be condemned and the owner will have a maximum of 15 days to remove it from the county or face a daily fine.

Before purchasing a moving mobile home permit; the information below is required:

- 1. Name of property owner and land lot #
- 2. Year model/manufacturer/serial number of mobile home
- 3. Name of certified mover & electrician
- 4. Septic Tank Permit (purchased through the Health Dept.)
- 5. 1-acre lot per dwelling is required or ½ acre if you are on an approved city water system.

6. Check with Tax Commissioners' office to see if taxes on mobile home have been paid prior to moving mobile home.

Cost of Mobile Home Permit: \$150.00 payable to ECBOC (Echols County Board of Commissioners).

Need to call 229-561-2639 (Chad McLeod) and schedule an inspection after the mobile home has been set up, wired and plumbing should be installed so power may be turned on.
