This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 16.987 mills, an increase of 2 mills. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than 14.987 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000.00 is approximately \$80.00 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$72,000.00 is approximately \$57.60.
