Commissioners' Discussion

The first item on the agenda was nuisance laws for Echols County. The Commissioners discussed the matter, and constituents in attendance addressed their concerns regarding nuisance laws and potential ordinances. The Board is currently in the process of developing ordinances intended to benefit all county constituents.

Code enforcement was also discussed, including the possibility of using a third-party vendor to issue citations for enforcing county ordinances. The County received a quote of \$15.00 per hour for approximately 20 hours per week.

Residential landfill stickers were discussed to help offset the cost of operating the landfill. The stickers would also assist in identifying authorized users and preventing outside contractors from utilizing the landfill. The proposed cost for the stickers is \$10.00, and possession of a sticker would be required to dispose of trash at the Echols County Landfill.

The lease of the old school board building was discussed, including the option of a floating lease or establishing a fixed monthly payment to the school board. This item will be brought forward for a vote at the next Board of Commissioners' meeting.

The cost of the county water system was also discussed. There has been some confusion regarding the cost of installing meters and the expenses associated with running the system.

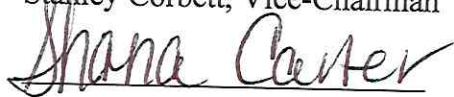
Adjournment
